#### **Application & Guidelines for Artists**

For the past eleven years, the Durham West Arts Centre has presented the Studio Tour as part of its commitment to art education and support for local artists. For two days each spring, area studios and artists welcome the public to view artwork, watch demonstrations (optional) and learn more about various creative productions within the region. This event is an excellent opportunity for local artists and artisans to showcase and sell their work from their host studios and sites which may otherwise not be regularly open to the public. The tour is self-guided and free of charge for visitors. Application is open to all artists and fine craft artists living and working in the Durham Region or invited guests working within the region.

The Durham West Arts Centre Studio Tour strives to achieve a fresh and interesting mix of new and returning artists and to include artists working in a variety of media.

#### The artists must be members of the Durham West Arts Centre: the artists must be

- committed, working at a competent level and viewed as such by their peers.
- must have a functioning studio space (or willing to be placed at a host site, or the Dr. Nelson F.
   Tomlinson Community Centre in Claremont) and display their work so it can be readily viewed by the public.
- must have original works, created by the artist, including but not limited to the following: painting, photography, drawing, sculpture, pottery, blown glass, carving, fibre art, printmaking, collage, stained glass, weaving and jewelry.

#### The Durham West Arts Centre is responsible for:

- administration
- assist with developing and managing the budget
- funding from sponsors and advertisers
- production of brochure and posters
- update and maintenance of website
- assist with publicity, promotion, and marketing
- production of road signs and directional arrows
- making payments for Studio Tour related activities



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#### Artists are responsible for:

- applications and support material delivered to DWAC on time and complete
- fees and requested material supplied timely
- distribution of artist's share of brochures and posters
- posting and removing directional studio tour signs
- ensuring studio space is safe and prepared to welcome visitors as well as guest artists should you be a hosting artist
- ensuring adequate liability insurance for the artist's studio. House insurance alone does not
  necessarily provide adequate coverage. DWAC takes no responsibility for personal
  loss or damage due to inadequate liability coverage at the site artist's locations.
- selling own artwork, accepting commissions, recruiting for classes, and offering/distributing promotional material
- offering demonstrations (optional) during the tour
- maintaining open studios both days of the tour and being available to the public
- assistance at the artist's studio at all times for rest breaks and safety
- keeping and reporting visitor statistics to DWAC

#### Application Deadline: Monday, October 15, 2018

Full Studio Tour fee payment is due with your application. The fee for 2018 will remain at \$ 175.00 which includes membership fees. Please make cheques payable to Durham West Arts Centre.

**NB:** all Guest Artists are required to make a full Studio Tour fee payment.

Withdrawal with refund is permitted only until print deadline December 15, 2018.
